The Post-Baccalaureate Certificate in Applied Economics (PBCAE) is a one-year graduate certificate that enables students upgrade their skills in economic and statistical analyses beyond the undergraduate level but avoiding the rigor of a master's level economics degree. It also serves as a bridging program for those intending to pursue a master's degree in economics.

By completing the PBCAE, you will be well-prepared to apply economic theories and concepts to real-world scenarios and make informed decisions in your chosen career path. The Sobeys School's PBCAE program will:

- enhance your basic skills in economic analysis needed to understand some day-to-day economic events.
- develops your basic quantitative skills needed to meet your career demands.
- help prepare you for graduate studies in economics if you are lacking some background courses.

Admission requirements

- Undergraduate degree with a minimum overall CGPA of 3.0.
- Required Economic courses:
 - Principles of Microeconomics
 - Principles of Macroeconomics
 - Introductory Statistics
- Three references
- Resume
- Supplemental form (short answer questions)
- Writing sample
- IELTS (Overall score of 6.5 with no band below 6.0)

Program Requirements:

Students admitted to the program must successfully complete six courses (equivalent of eighteen (18) credit hours) with a GPA of 2.20 or higher (noting that completion with a GPA of 3.0 or higher is required for consideration of acceptance into the MAE program).

Core Courses include:

- ECON 5500 Microeconomics
- ECON 5501 Macroeconomics
- ECON 5503 Economic Statistics

PBCAE students must also take three electives offered at 4000 level or above. Those interested in pursuing a master's degree in economics upon completion of PBCAE are strongly advised to take the following electives:

- » Mathematical Economics (ECON 5502)
- » Either Advanced Microeconomics Theory (ECON 5600) or Advanced Macroeconomics Theory (ECON 5601)
- » Econometrics (ECON 5603)
