ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

To be eligible for admission to the Master of Technology Entrepreneurship and Innovation program, applicants are normally required to have an undergraduate degree with at least a “B” average and attained a minimum grade point average (GPA) of at least a 3.0 in the candidate’s final sixty (60) credit hours taken at university. In exceptional circumstances, when an applicant is otherwise qualified, the admissions committee may waive this requirement.

Graduate Funding: All applicants who apply by April 1 are considered for graduate funding and those who are successful are officially notified by the Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research (FGSR).

Additional documents required:

1. A one-page description of what the student expects to learn in the MTEI program and how it will benefit them and/or their organization.
2. A current CV/Resume.
3. Transcripts: We will accept uploaded unofficial transcripts for evaluation purposes. Applicants must upload a grading scale with their unofficial transcripts. Successful applicants will be required to submit official final transcripts.
4. Two (2) Recommendation Forms, one of which should be from an academic source.
5. Official Proof of English Language Proficiency (if required).
